& Assigns the said James Swin have granted bargain
sold aliened, conveyed, and confirmed and by these presents
do, grant, bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto the
said John Crichton Exec^r of W^m Crichton dec^d his heirs Assigns
one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being near the Town
of Simonton in the County of G^o Simonton (explicating the title of
William Crichton the said Land being number Twenty of the
said Town of Simonton) and containing by Estimation and
Acres and bounded as follows (to wit) beginning
at the south west corner of the said W^m Crichton's Lot being
numbered West Thirteen Acres.
