This Indenture made the 13th day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred and three & in the 27th year of the commonwealth, between Rob^t Mahy and Rebecca his wife of the County of S^campton of the one part, and James Wilkinson of the said County of the other part - Witnesses: That the s^d Rob^t Mahy and Rebecca his wife in consideration of the sum of five hundred and thirty five dollars lawful money of this commonwealth to them in hand paid, by the s^d James Wilkinson at or before the making & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents and each of them doth bargain & sell unto the s^d James Wilkinson his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying on the south side of the Blue Creek in the County of S^campton containing One hundred and twenty five half acres bounded as followeth. Beginning at John Williamson's line at the Blue Creek thence along the said Williamson's line to the land belonging to the State of New York thence along the said Phelps' line to the run of the Blue Creek thence up the said Creek to the beginning together with all the advantages whatsoever to the s^d tract or parcel of land belonging or in anywise appertaining to the s^d James Wilkinson and his heirs and assigns with every part & parcel thereof to the said James Wilkinson his heirs & assigns & to the s^d Rob^t Mahy and Rebecca his wife for themselves and their heirs the said Land
