This Indenture, made this 21st day of February in the
year four last past 1803. Between Augustus B. Simmons of
the parish of Nottaway, and County of S^o Hampton, of the
one part and Benjamin Vick of the same Parish and County of
the other part - Witnesseth that in the said Augustus B.
Simmons for and in consideration of the sum of Forty two pounds,
Current money of Virginia, to him in hand paid at or before, the
enacting and sealing, of these presents, the receipt whereof the
said Augustus B. Simmons, with him by Acknowledg, and thereof
disquit, and discharge, the said Benjamin Vick, his heirs executors
and Administrators, by these presents to the said Augustus
B. Simmons. His heirs assigns, and said. and by these,
present, with great bargain, and sell. unto the said Ben^o
Vick and to his heirs or assigns forever - One certain tract
or parcel of land, lying and being in the parish and County
aforesaid. Containing by Estimation Forty Acres (more or less)
it being all my part of the lands called Clifton tract,
which part fell to me, by the last deed Thomas Simmons
with the Heirs, wife, executors, Profits, Commodities
Herediments and Appurtenances, is that over to the said
Plantation tract or parcel of land belonging or in any
wise appertaining, and revenues Dividends, remainder
and remainments unto profits thereof and of every part &
parcel thereof, and all things to title, Interest, or claim
whosoever of him the s^d Augustus B. Simmons or his heirs
to him the s^d Ben^o Vick & to his heirs and assigns forever
To have and to hold the said plantation, Tracts or parcel
of land & premises with the appurtenances to the same belonging
to the said Ben^o Vick &c, the rights and title of the said
land, the said Augustus B. Simmons doth grant, give warrant
and power upon, against all persons or persons claiming
or demanding the same, on any part or parcel thereof
