money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Wm. P. Westbrook the
receipt whereof the said Isiah Dashell and Sarah his wife do hereby
acknowledge the said Isiah Dashell and Sarah his wife have granted
bargained sold aliened and conveyed and do by these presents grant
bargain, sell, and convey unto the said Wm. P. Westbrook his heirs and
assigns forever certain Tracts or parcels of land lying in the County of
his state of Virginia & being the whole of a tract of land that was formerly
of his ancestor and Bournage as follows (to wit) by the land and of his
Child, Henry Thayer, and the lands belonging to the estate of Anna Harris de-
ceased consisting of twenty five acres better or more or less. Together with several
newly discovered, and a portion, more and more of the said land and
premises and every part or parcel thereof & the right title interest claim and
demand whatsoever of the said Isiah Dashell and Sarah his wife
and to the said land premises and every part or parcel thereof. To
have and to hold the said land and premises with the appurtenances
unto the said Wm. P. Westbrook his heirs and assigns forever and the said
Isiah Dashell and Sarah his wife for them selves and their heirs
