This Indenture made the 10<sup>th</sup> day of Decr in the year four  
Let one thousand eight hundred and one between Isaac Olson and Lucy his  
wife of the County of Dinwiddie of the one part and John Prince of the County  
of Surry of the other part Witnesseth that the said Isaac Olson and  
Lucy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds  
Current money to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
-ledged with grant bargain over and deliver unto the said John Prince  
one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County  
of Southampton and Parish of Saint Luke and within the Northside of  
the three Creeks containing by estimation Eighty three and one third Acres  
more or less which said tract or parcel of land was out a part of the  
said Lucy Olson proportion of the lands of her Brother Henry Myrick  
and by virtue of a decree of the County Court of Southampton reference  
being had thereto will more fully appear and is bounded as follows  
(to wit) Beginning at a corner tree between Peter Simmons and the said Olson  
thence along the said Simmons line South 11<sup>th</sup> 26<sup>th</sup> Pole to a corner on  
Hence Myricks Tract line thence along his line North 8<sup>th</sup> 0<sup>th</sup> 40<sup>th</sup> Pole  
to a corner of John Myricks (sup<sup>d</sup> ass<sup>d</sup>) and thence along his line North 5<sup>th</sup>  
East 2<sup>th</sup> 31<sup>th</sup> Pole to and back on the one of the same swamp thence around  
the swamp to the beginning. To have and to hold the said tract or par-  
-cel of land and premises with the appurtenances unto the said John  
Prince his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of  
him the said John Prince his heirs and assigns forever and they the  
said Isaac Olson and Lucy his wife the said tract or parcel of land  
unto the said John Prince unto his heirs against them the said Isaac  
Olson and Lucy his wife and their executors and respective heirs and assigns  
and every other person or persons whatsoever share and wife Isaac  
and Lucy agreed by their presents In witness whereof they the  
said Isaac Olson and Lucy his wife hereunto set their hands  
and seals the day and year before written.
