and we do Command you to go personally to the said Sylvia
and examine her privately and apart from her husband,
whether she hath executed the said deed freely and
voluntarily without the persuasion or threat of her husband
and whether she is willing the said deed should be recorded in the

as aforesaid then you distinctly and openly certify in presence
