Witnesseth that the said Thomas Gillman and Sally his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Seven hundred and fifty pounds to him in hand paid by the said Benjamin Wren before the sealing and delivering of these presents whereof the said Thomas Gillman and Sally his wife with hisly acknowledged hath granted bargain and sold and with by these presents granted bargain and sell into the said Benjamin Wren his heirs and assigns forever certain tract or piece of land lying and being in the south side of Mottaway River in the County of B^oampton and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a post in the stream of the Razon Swamp corner of Thomas Scott land thence along his line S. 10 E. 130 poles to a pine thence S. 34 poles to a black oak corner of Charles Barkhams land thence along his line S. 73 true 128 to a pine thence west 76 poles to a pine thence N. 34 E. 40 poles thence S. 14 poles to a white gum on the road thence along the road N. 10 E. 40 poles thence N. 22 E. 58 poles to a pine corner of James Barkhams land thence along his line N. 57 W. 50 poles to a white oak thence N. 56 W. 6 poles to a white oak thence along his line N. 55 E. 2 poles to a white oak thence N. 5 poles E. 44 poles to a sweet gum by the side of Sams hards thence down the run of Sams hards 84 poles to the mouth and thence down the run of the Razon swamp to the beginning. To have and to hold the said land with all and singular tenures thereunto belonging to the said Wren his heirs and assigns forever to the use of the person now and hereafter the said Thomas Gillman and Sally his wife and assigns forever and to the said Wren his heirs and assigns forever by their presents selling the right and title of the said land and every part thereof to him claiming by title of purchase or under in the S^d Gillman and wife.
