Paris Indenture made this 16th day of May in the
year of our Lord 1803. Between Orndell Rowe and Charlotte
his wife of the County of Southampton and parish of Mottissey
of the one parts and Samuel Beale of the same county and
parish of the other Witnesses that the said Orndell Rowe
and Charlotte his wife for and in consideration of the just and
good sum of three hundred dollars Current money of Virginia
by the said Samuel Beale to them in hand paid before the making
and signing of these presents the receipt where the said Orndell Rowe
and Charlotte his wife doth hereby acknowledge and the receipt
request and discharge the said Samuel Beale his heirs and assigns
former and thereafter therewith to be fully and truly satisfied
Contracted and paid they the said Orndell Rowe and Charlotte his
wife have granted bargain'd sold aliene'd release'd set
over deliver'd and confirm'd and by these presents doth grant
bargain sell aliene'd release'd set over deliver'd and confirm'd
unto the said Samuel Beale and to his heirs and assigns forever
All that Messuage Tract plantation or parcel of land whereon
The said Orndell Rowe now lives it being a part of a tract of
land formerly belonging to Henry Soyner dec'd which he sold
to Joshua Soyner and Eleanor his wife Peter Forster and Soyner
his wife and John Soyner and Sally his wife they being
the heirs of said Henry Soyner dec'd who sold and convey'd
the same to the above named Orndell Rowe by deed bearing
date the 9th day of September 1796) Situate lying
and being in the County of Southampton and parish
of Mottissey expressing on the Expressions containing
by estimation one hundred acres more or less and bounded
as follows (to wit) Beginning with the Cypress swamp at
a white oak in the mouth of a small branch a corner tree
of said land standing in Johna Corbett line thence westward
thence to a pine in Johna Corbett line thence said Corbett line formerly
thence a straight line to a maple standing in Johna Turner and
Thence across the run of said branch to the Cypress swamp thence
down the run of said branch to the white oak being the first
station and also the lower end of said branch being the first
grape arched and water comes for the Commodities hereof turn
ing over to the same belonging Or in any way or appurten-
ance and the reversion and reversion and annuities and annuities
into issue and profits thereof of all the estate right
title Interest claim and demand of the said Orndell
Rowe and Charlotte his wife &c.
