Braddock This Indenture made this 8th day of October 1812
between Henry Braddock of Southampton County State of Virginia
and state of Virginia of the other parts Writetheth that
he said Henry Braddock, for and in consideration
of the sum of one hundred dollars in hand paid to the
said Henry Braddock the receipt whereof which is
hereby acknowledged hath granted sold conveyed
and by these presents doth bargain sell and sell unto
the said James Wilkinson a certain tract or parcel of
land lying and being in the County of Southampton
situated on the North side of Elizabeth River containing
by estimation two hundred acres more or less and bounded
as follows - Beginning at a Hickory on the side of Ashmun
River in the County here from thence west along the said
County line to a cedar pine in Edmund Turner line thence
along said Turner line to another pine across in O. Wilkinson
line to Meherrin River a fence thence up the said River
to the beginning To have and to hold the said land
and premises with its appurtenances to the said proper
use and behoof of him the said Wilkinson his heirs
etc. Given and the said Henry Braddock for himself his
heirs etc. doth Given in witness and signed the title of the
same against all and every person or persons whatsoever

hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal this day
