 one further sick and down one pair hand Span & one pair
 Sings and Shave and one Iron pot - To have and to
 hold the said property, consisting of one feather bed
 and furniture &c - as here expressed unto him his heirs
 and assigns forever he receipted and assigns forever
 unto the said Sarah Johnson for her self her heirs
 and assigns the said property unto the said Shadrach
 Doyce his heirs and assigns and assigns a quit the claim of
 her the said Sarah Johnson her heirs and assigns and
 assigns the claim on claim of all and every person or
 persons whatsoever shall & will warrant & forever defend
