

Estimation Three hundred were both some more
 or less, it being the land bought by the said Snow worth of

 one & a half acres of land & Phelps and many
 his wife bearing date the 22nd day of November
 1798. To have over to hold the said bargain'd
 premises with all the profits & improvements and appurtenances
 belonging from or belonging in anywise to the same;
 to him the said Eleazar Hannell his heirs and assigns
 forever; And they the said Joseph & Snowworth
 & Joannah his wife for them selves their heirs Executors
 & Admins do and will warrant and forever defend the said
 bargain'd premises against the lawful claim or
 demand of any one way person whatsoever; to him the
 said Eleazar Hannell his heirs and assigns forever. In

 and Joannah his wife have hereunto set their hands
 & affix'd their seals this day and year first above written.
