 and annuities Rent Issues & profits thereof & every part  
 & parcel thereof & the said John alone and Charlotte  
 his wife for them selves their heirs & assigns with warrant  
 & power against the fee Simple right and title of the said  
 land and premises, unto the said John Bowers his heirs
