

And the said Matthew Johnson for himself his heirs, Executors and assigns, the said plantation together with and parcel of one hundred and fifty five acres of land and premises with all the appurtenances aforesaid, with all & along the other granted premises good & chattels unto him the said James Scott and his heirs & assigns forever, against him the said Matthew Johnson his heirs Executors administrators and assigns & against all persons whatsoever, claiming or demanding the same or any parts parcel or articles thereof shall & will, woman and fore on defence by these presents, and the said Matthew Johnson for himself, his heirs Executors administrators and assigns with hereby Covenant promise & agree to & with the said James Scott his heirs Executors administrators & assigns that he the said Matthew Johnson his heirs Executors administrators or assigns will and lawfully pay or cause to be paid unto the said James Scott his heirs & assigns the just and full sum of two hundred dollars like money of Virginia with lawful interest there upon from the first day of next June & upon the special Condition the Indenture is to be void, & the said Matthew Johnson his heirs or assigns to repossess the said granted premises as fully & lawfully as his heirs and assigns his seal this day and year above written.
