This Indenture made this 16th day of January
in the year of our lord 1815 - Between Matthew Weston of the
County of the up part and Elbert Williams same County of the
other part *Witnesseth* that the said Matthew Weston
for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred, and eight
dollars to him in hand paid by the said Elbert Williams the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Matthew
Weston hath granted bargained sold and conveyed and
confirmed unto the said Elbert Williams his heirs and assigns for
ever one certain tract or parcel of land containing by
estimation thirty five acres both the same more or less
lying and being in the County of Southampton on black
water road from Salisbury and bounded as follows (W^{est})
Beginning at a post oak near of the road thence a new line of 10 rods
thence N. 5 E. W. 95 pole to the old line and oak then along
that old line S 70 W. 90 pole to a corner light wood stake then
S 6 E. 130 pole to a pine tree of the road I then said road to the beginning
To have and to hold the said tract of land and premises
and every part and parcel thereof unto the heirs executors and assigns
of him the said Matthew Weston naming their person
or persons claiming under him of us and to the said premises
all and singular the said land above mentioned unto the said
Elbert Williams for him self & his heirs the said tract of land
and every part thereof against him self and his heirs and
against all and every other person & persons whatsoever to the
said Elbert Williams his heirs and assigns share and to be
warranted and forever defended by the executors & assigns
of him the said Matthew Weston have hereunto set his hand
