This Indenture made the 10th day of May in the
 year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty Between

 that the said John Thomas for and in consideration of the
 sum of two hundred & fifty £ Dollars to him in hand paid
 by the said Henry Thomas the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged by the said John Thomas hath granted
 bargained and sold Aligned Enfeoffed and confirmed unto the
 said Henry Thomas his heirs and assigns forever one certain
 tract or piece of land containing by Estimation
 fifty one acre (to the same more or less) situate lying &
 being in the County of Stumpson on the South side of Stumpson
 River and bounded as follows (Viz) Beginning at a
 gum in a grassy branch thence up said branch the various
 18 1/2 pds to to the fork of another then down the other
 branch binding to Henry Thomas do unto the various
 Course 200 pds to a corner which oak then up E. and
 two of marked trees to the first - To have and
 to hold the said tract of land land and premises
 Henry and heirs there of and also their heirs and
 assigns forever and remainder right title Interest
 Claim and demand whatsoever of him the said John
 or any other person or persons claiming under him or
 his to the said premises and singular the said
 land above mentioned unto the said Henry for
 himself and heirs the said tract of land and
 premises then of against himself and his heirs &
 against all and every other person & person whatsoever
 to the said Henry Thomas his heirs & assigns shall and lawfully
 warrant & never defend by these presents In Witness
