

1881 Know all men by these presents that I John Daugherty
of St.ampton County for & in consideration of
to hundred & thirty two dollars to me in hand paid by
Dolan John Daugherty receipt where of is hereby acknowledged
have granted sold & delivered, & by these presents do hereby
sell & deliver to the said John Dolan, a Negro man and

named Ben & Magoo boy named Sack. & I the
said John Daugherty for myself & my heirs
the said Negro Ben & Sack to the said John Dolan
his heirs & assigns, etc. & will by these presents from
Mortgage & Voluntary against all and every person or
persons whatsoever, it is now the left to be unincumbered
that if the said John Daugherty shall within three
Months from the date here of pay the said John
Dolan the above sum of two hundred & thirty two dol-
-lars with legal interest, then this Bill of sale to be
Void otherwise the said John Dolan his heirs, Executors
Widow & assigns is hereby authorized & empowered
after ^{giving} ten days public Notice, to sell the said Negro
Ben & Sack or either of them if sufficient to pay
the above debt & charges at public sale to highest
bidder for Cash & the issues of the money arising
from such sale of any to the said John Daugherty
his heirs or assigns, shall pay or cum and in witness
of the above I the said John Daugherty have hereunto
set my hand & seal March 2^d of 1853 -
