This Indentured under the hand of James Clement
in the year Eighteen Hundred between John Simmons of the
County of Southampton of the one part & James Clement of the
County of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that the said
John Simmons for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred
pounds lawful money of Great Britain to him in hand paid by the said
James Clement at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents
the receipt whereof is here by Acknowledged, have bargained
& sold unto the said James Clement his heirs & assigns the
following property (to wit) one negro man, Jeffrey Peter, Dark
(fair black Smith) young, Sarah, young, white, Patience, black
Wagon, Lewis, & Ring, also one grey mare, bay mare, two horses
Mexican, one bay Horse, one bay gelding, twenty five cattle, Faint
Sheep Fair feather beds, & Furniture, one Walnut Tree,
two flag & cotton chairs, one looking glass three Wainscot
two piece Tables, Fair Iron pots & one Dutch oven, one Bath,
To have and to hold the above said property unto
the said James Clement his heirs & assigns forever. To have
the only proper use & behoof of him the said James Clement his
heirs and assigns forever. To the said John Simmons for himself
which he doth unto the said James Clement his heirs & assigns
freedom the claim, of him the said John Simmons and him
of his & every other person or persons whatsoever, shall, will,
do or command to be done or suffered by him the said James Clement
the said John Simmons hath hereunto set his hand & Affixed
his Seal the day & year above written
