 I, James Scott of St. James County Virginia having under my
 name a negro man named Nathan Scott who was born the 19th day of July
 1815 and eight hundred, whose father to wit, had been a slave
 but being found free and that freedom is the natural right of
 all men black, so then hereby, emancipate & set free the said
 Nathan Scott, and do for my self my heirs, executors & assigns
 here by relinquish all my right title claim & claim in pretension
 of claim, whatsoever, which I have or may have to any estate, human or
 upon Negroes & saving nothing myself & assigns the said
 and direction of the said Nathan Scott until he shall arrive
 to Law full age and then to enjoy his full freedom without
 interruption from me or any person claiming for by or from me
