

This Indenture made the 10th day of June Anno
Domini 1875 Between Henry Harris of the state of Georgia
of the one part and Humphrey Dewey of the county of
Lumpkin of the other part, Wherefore that the said
Henry Harris for and in consideration of the sum of two Hundred
and Dollars, to him in hand paid by the said Dewey at
and above the sealing hereof of the said Harris, the receipt
of which he hereby acknowledges, there of I have well paid the
debt due to him by the said Dewey; Have granted, bargained
and sold, aliened, conveyed & confirmed, and by these presents
do, and I doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, convey & con-
firm to the said Humphrey Dewey, his heirs, assigns
all my right title Interest Claim, Property, or demand which
I have in a certain tract of land and its appurtenances
laying in the County of Lumpkin on the South side of
the White Oak Creek commonly called the Great Water head
containing by a last survey six hundred & seventy
seven Acres being the same land mentioned in the will of
James Harris Dec'd as containing five hundred & thirty
seven Acres or less & divided by this said James Harris is
his said will to be equally divided between Wm & Geo
Harris, which said Wm has since departed this life in-
testate and without any child leaving, the said Henry
Harris his brother, with seven other Brothers & Sisters or
their representatives to whom by law his the said Wm Harris
was of the said land descended as that at the time the
said Henry Harris party hereunto is entitled to the
right half of of three hundred & thirty seven acres of the
said tract of land - To have I do hold accomplish
said Henry Harris, right title Interest, in the above
said tract of land and premises (being one eighth part of the
same as aforesaid to him the said Humphrey Dewey
his heirs & assigns forever, & the said Henry Harris for them-
self & his heirs & assigns other persons or persons claiming by
or under him the said Henry Harris and the said Henry
Harris for him self his heirs & assigns, as to the said
covenant to and with the said Humphrey Dewey his
heirs & assigns forever will extend the right & title of
the said land & premises here by grants made to the said Hen-
ry Dewey his heirs & assigns forever - And Witness
