1810 Between Benjamin Bittle of the county of Southampton
 of Virginia of the one part & William Pascoe Wentworth of the
 same county of the other Part Whereby the
 said Benj^r Bittle for and in consideration of the sum
 of One hundred & Forty one pounds current money of Virginia
 to use in hand paid & the receipt whereof is so hereby acknowledged
 the said Benj^r Bittle have granted bargained sold conveyed
 Released from all Tax by these Presents granted bargained sold conveyed
 unto the said William P. Wentworth his heirs & assigns forever
 Certain tract or parcels of land lying & being in the County of
 Southampton State of Virginia to be the whole of the land & premises
 the said Benj^r Bittle of Joshua Clark containing the lands
 & so used to be the same more or less Together with all revenues &
 services due unto & profits & emoluments of the said land & premises
 Every part or parcel thereof & belonging to the said Bittle & his
 assigns whatsoever of the aforesaid Benj^r Bittle of and in
 the said land & premises according to the power thereof
 to have and to hold the said land & premises with the
 Appurtenances unto the said Wm. P. Wentworth his heirs & assigns
 forever and the said Benj^r Bittle for himself & his assigns
 the said land and premises as Every part or parcel of the said land
 other person or persons whatsoever to the said Wm. P. Wentworth his
 heirs & assigns forever & shall and will defend by these presents
 Past Benj^r Bittle & Wm. P. Wentworth that if the said Benj^r
 Bittle should ever lawfully pay or cause to be paid without fraud
 or delay Whichever of the said Wm. P. Wentworth the greater
 Sum of One hundred & Forty one pounds with the Lawfull
 Interest from the date hereof Wm. P. before the 25th day of
 Decem^r Next bearing the date hereof & then within the
 above inclosed time to the said Wm. P. Wentworth shall take these One hundred & Forty one
 to wit the above bargained premises of the said Benj^r Bittle
