

147 This Indenture made on the 24th day of January in the year of our Lord, 1803. Between Benjamin Johnson, and Polly his wife of Southampton and State of Virginia, of the one part, and Soniah Vick of the County and State aforesaid, of the one part, witnesseth, that the said Benjamin & his wife Polly for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and nine hundred & silver dollars, already in hand, then and by these presents do give, grant, bargain, and sell, unto the said Soniah Vick, his heirs and assigns forever, three certain tracts or parcels of land, lying and being in the said County of Southampton, to-wit: one tract which the said Benjamin purchased of Wm. Barnes & others the 19th day of October, in the year 1793, and is of more or less in the said County of Southampton, containing one hundred & forty nine & eight tenths of an acre, more or less, the particulars hereof of which will appear by reference to the said deed - also another tract, which the said Ben^g purchased of Soniah Vick & Elizabeth his wife, as by their deed bearing date on the 11th day of January in the year 1799, and is of more or less in the said County of Southampton, containing by estimation two hundred & acres, both more or less; the boundaries of which will fully appear by reference to the said deed - The other tract which the said Ben^g purchased of Samuel & Lucy his wife & Wm. Holloman and Betsy his wife, as by their deed bearing date on the 30th day of November in the year 1799, and is of more or less in the said County of Southampton, containing by estimation half an acre, both more or less, the boundaries of which will fully appear by reference to the said deed - all which several tracts together amount to three hundred and ninety five and four tenths of an acre - To have and to hold the said tracts or parcels of land together with and every their appurtenances, unto the said Soniah, his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Soniah Vick and his heirs and assigns forever - and the said Ben^g Johnson & Polly his wife their heirs, executors, and assigns, the said three tracts or parcels of land, with all and every their appurtenances, unto him the said Soniah Vick and his heirs, & assigns, shall and will forever remain, to be enjoyed by them and their heirs and assigns forever - In witness whereof the said Ben^g Johnson and his wife Polly have hereunto set their hands and seals the very day and year first before written.
