

This Indenture made the eighth day of June with year of our
Lord's thousand eight hundred and third between Benjamin
Nichols, B. Nicholson & Littleton Mason, Commissioners Appointed
by the Honorable Court of S. C. at a Court held for the S. C. County with
month of March last past, appointing the S. C. Commissioners to do the land
belonging to the estate of Mr. Blake dec'd of the one part & Eliza. B. Blane,
Heirs of the County of S. C. of the other part, witnesseth, that with the
S. C. Mr. Benjamin Nichols, B. Nicholson & Littleton Mason
Commissioners as aforesaid, hath agreed to the aforesaid Decretal order
and in conformity to the said order and in consideration of the sum of one
thousand and two pounds sixteen shillings and six pence lawful
money of Virginia to them the S. C. Commissioners within and by the S. C.
Eliza. B. Blane, at or before the sealing and delivery of this present
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath Benjamin & Littleton
Mason present with Benjamin, sole and confirmed, unto the said Eliza. B.
Blane, her heirs executors Administrators or assigns forever, one certain tract
or parcel of land, siting also the lands the said Mr. Blake dec'd and
in the S. C. County of S. C. containing one hundred and eleven acres, so
the same more or less, lying on the Angelica Swamp in the S. C. County of
hundred as follows to wit: Beginning at a post or corner a corner of George
Stephenson's land, thence along S. 84° W. 205 paces
to a living stump a corner of Matthews land thence along N. West
to a living stump a corner in a line or corner, thence nearly east to
a living stump, then to the corner of S. C. Swamp, to the mouth the bar
to a post or corner, thence N. West 45 degrees East to a white oak a corner
of Drews land, thence the same course to a pine a corner of S. C. land
thence along a line that divides the land that was
Thomas Blake's land from Drews land to the beginning, it being a
part of tract of land granted to Thomas Blake by Patent bearing
date the 15th of Novr with the year 1785. To have and to hold to the
said Eliza. B. Blane and appointing her heirs and assigns forever, with the S. C.
B. Nicholson & Littleton Mason Commissioners as aforesaid, with Benjamin
present, absolutely convey & confirm unto the said Eliza. B. Blane her
heirs and assigns forever, all and singular things and little things
