 Other part, Witnesseth, that the said Arthur Turner & Henry his
 wife for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred & fifty pounds
 eight shillings Virginia money to him in hand paid by the said
 Blunt who receipt thereof the said Arthur Turner doth hereby acknowledge
 to be fully satisfied and paid hath bargain sold, sold, alienated, alien-
 ment confirmed and doth by these presents fully and absolutely pro-
 bargain sold and confirmed unto the said W^m Blunt his heirs & assigns
 forever One certain tract or parcel of land containing of Twenty-
 three & twenty six acres and a half Acres - to the same more ab-
 lying & being in the County of Siler aforesaid & bounded as follows
 Beginning at a pine in corner tree in first Division near Willards
 Spring thence South 53° 6' W pole to a red oak thence S. 87° 10'
 W pole to a gum in the head of the present branch
 thence N. 87° 10' W pole to a post oak thence N. 61° 10' W pole
 to a red oak thence N. 48° W. 74 pole to a white oak thence S. 83°
 E. 125 pole to a pine thence N. 22° 3' W. 45 pole to a hickory thence
 N. 52° W. 20 pole to a pine thence N. 0° 7' 1/2 W. 64 pole to a second pine
 thence 78° W. 50 pole to a post oak thence S. 97° W. 137 pole to
 a pine thence S. 2nd of 60 degrees W. 26 pole to a post oak - thence S. 87°
 to the beginning - To have and to hold the above premises
 unto the said W^m Blunt his heirs & assigns forever together with all the appur-
 tenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining sit-
