 parcel of land in the County of Southampton, being the same land
 which the said Thomas purchased of Joses Gardner and Sally his wife
 as by their deed of bargain and sell, bearing date the fourteenth day
 of December 1801, and is of Record in the County Court of
 Southampton, containing by Estimation one hundred and twenty eight
 be the same more or less, and bounded as follows (Vizt); Beginning
 at a Red Oak a corner of the said Will's land, thence along the said
 Will's line to a Hickory a corner two, thence along the Globe land
 now in the occupation of Nott Wadsworth to a gum in Humphreys branch, thence
 along the said Humphreys branch to a gum a corner two in the said Will's land, thence
