 title, Interest, Claim and demand, which the s^d Elizth hold
 and hold in the tract of land and premises afores^d. To have
 and to hold the said land and premises, with its appurtenances unto
 the said John his heirs & assigns, for during the life time of the s^d
 Elizth Day and the said Elizth and J^{ts}, for themselves and
 their heirs, do hereby Covenant and agree to and with the said John
 Barron to warrant and forever defend, all their right, title, interest,
 of, in and to the Tract of land and premises, afores^d unto the s^d
 John Barron his heirs and assigns against the claim of any person whom
 In Witness where of the said Elizth J^{ts} have here unto, respectively
 at their hands and affixed their seals, the day and year within written
