Know all men by these Presents that I, James Epp of Southampton  
County Virginia do deliver to John Sojourner of the county aforesaid aforesaid  
one horse and forty barrels of corn the corn was at Capt. James  
Willis and the horse in the care of John Sojourner the corn to be received by  
Sojourner and any time when he think fit to receive it which horse and  
forty barrels of corn I do set over and deliver to said John Sojourner to be  
received from me from the 1<sup>st</sup> Mo to 1<sup>st</sup> Agust and I do by these presents  
give to John Sojourner a full perfect right to said horse and Corn for the  
length of the above account & I do by these presents warrant and give  
up the property to said John Sojourner his heirs and assigns against all other  
person claiming any right wth the consideration that when the above mentioned  
horse and Sojourner has received after satisfaction for the aforesaid horse  
I may have corn to return same to the lawfull property of said lawfull property  
and the bill of sale had not been given - I do witness whereof we have at our  
hands & seals the 10<sup>th</sup> day of March 1803 - James Epp
