 Powell's branch or corner tree in Lot N^o One, thence along along
 of marshes trees lately Chape N^o thence along east to a pine in
 James Harris line to Williams Blunt's line, thence along the vari-
 ous courses of said Blunt's line to Meherrin River, thence down the
 side of the River to Henry Smith's line, thence along said Smith's
 line to Powell's branch the line of Lot N^o One, thence up the
 line which is upper end of said Branch to the beginning, together
 with all houses, orchards, woods, waters, and water courses, privileges
 and hereditaments and appurtenances then unto belonging or in
 anywise appertaining, To have and to hold the said granted
 land and premises to the only proper use and behoof of him the Laurence
