

195 This Indenture made this 17 day of October 1803.

Between Sam. Kello of the town of Jerusalem of the one part
to David Windom of the 2^d town of the other part -
Witness that whereas the said Sam. Kello hath been
appointed a trustee for the purpose of selling a tract of land
which was conveyed by Jas. W. Winbourn to the 2^d Kello
for the purpose of securing a Debt due to the 2^d Windom
and the 2^d Kello for and in consideration of the sum
of one hundred and seventy two dollars to him in hand
paid by the 2^d Windom to and in satisfaction of the debt
due from the 2^d Jas. W. Winbourn to the 2^d Windom hath
granted bargain and sold and by these presents doth
grant bargain and sell unto the 2^d David Windom
to him his heirs or assigns with its appurtenances
lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and
to the W. Side of the Creek the lands B. - well fully
appears by referring to a deed given by William Griffin to
Jas. W. Winbourn and which has been recorded in the County
Court of Southampton aforesaid. To have and to hold the
tract land unto him the 2^d David Windom & to his heirs and
to the only proper use and behoof of him the 2^d David
Windom his heirs and assigns & the 2^d Sam. Kello as trustees of the
the 2^d land and appurtenances shall and will remain and
and forever defend against the claims and demands of the 2^d
Jas. W. Winbourn his heirs and assigns and against the claims & demands
of any person or persons claiming by from or under him in
