This Indenture made this 17th day of October, in the year
four Lord 1803 Between Henry Johnson and Rebekah his wife
of Southampton County, Notaway Parish, and Virginia State of the one
parts and Joshua Corbit of the County and state aforesaid of the other
parts Witnesseth that the said Henry Johnson and Rebekah
his wife for and in consideration of just and full sum of six
hundred & Twenty Dollars current money of Virginia by the
said Joshua Corbit to them in hand paid, before the sealing
and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof the said Henry
Johnson and Rebekah his wife do hereby acknowledge and
thereof acquit and discharge the said Joshua Corbit and his heirs
and assigns forever, and then ~~and~~ ^{and} thereunto fully and entirely
satisfied, contented and paid, they the said Henry Johnson and
Rebekah his wife, have granted, sold, aliened, conveyed
in released, sold over, delivered and confirmed, and by these presents
against bargain sell alien release, set over, deliver & confirm
unto the said Joshua Corbit, and to his heirs and assigns forever, as
certain part of a tract of Land which the said Henry Johnson
formerly of the County of Albemarle doth & (and is the same whereon the
said Henry Johnson now lives) Situate lying and being in the
County and Parish aforesaid containing by estimation two hundred
and sixty four acres, to the same more or less, bounded as follows
to wit: Beginning at the Pine of by pass Swamp and at the corner
of a branch, a dividing line between this tract and Williams
Pepus, thence up the Run of said branch to a white oak corner
tree in said Run Pepus and Int. Bowens line, thence along the
said Bowens line, to a pine corner tree in said Bowens & Johnson
Runners line, thence along the said Bowens line to a pine
corner tree thence a long line of marked trees to another
corner tree, thence along a line of marked trees to a corner
(Corner)
