This Indenture made this 12th day of October in the year of our
Said 1800, between Peter Simmons & Peggy his wife, of the County
of Sumpter of the one part & Lucy Simmons of the sd County,
Witness that the said Peter Simmons & Peggy his wife for
and in consideration of the sum of thirty three pounds to me
in hand paid by the sd Lucy Simmons the receipt whereof is hereby
declared, have sold bargained and sold and delivered unto the sd Lucy
Simmons and her heirs and assigns of land being & lying in the County
of Sumpter lying & being on the south side of Mettawag river bounded
(first) begining at a corner tree on the corner swamp dividing between
the sd Peter Simmons & John Prince from thence by a line of marked
trees dividing between the sd Peter Simmons & Peggy his wife & John
Prince to a corner tree on Howell's dyke line from thence 403 paces
by a line of marked trees dividing between the sd Peter Simmons
and Peggy his wife and John Prince from thence N. 76. E. by a
line of marked trees dividing between the sd Peter Simmons
& Peggy his wife & John Prince to a corner tree on the sd Howell's
dyke
