 hereby Acknowledged before the sealing and delivery of these presents that
 the sd George Coyer and Polly his wife have granted, bargained,
 sold, released, conveyed, conveyed and confirmed unto the sd Isaac Mickle-
 wood as him, his heirs and assigns, one certain tract or parcel of
 land, situated lying and being in the County of Southampton
 -beginning one half acre & several less better described as follows, and is

 the same belonging to the heirs of W^m Micklewood thence
