 -gent expenses from the 15th day April 1791 till paid to them in hand

 -sioners the hereby acknowledge they the s^d Commissioners have
 granted sold conveyed sold, delivered, and confirmed unto the
 s^d Robt. Godwyn his heirs and assigns forever two certain tracts of

 within the Sec of Mottoring River and bounded as follows (viz) the
