Know ye that I Pilgrim Wick of the County of S^campton and State of Virginia, for many years past and valuable considerations in thence moving on for the love good will and affection I bear towards my loving son Samuel Wick do give and grant with by these Presents of my full power unto my s^d son Samuel Wick his heirs and assigns forever (after my decease provides my said son should survive me) the land and Plantations whereon I now live containing by Estimation two hundred and five acres to the same more or less with the appurtenances thence belonging I have and to hold the s^d two hundred and five acres of land with all the appurtenances as afores^d from and after my decease free from any claim of the s^d Pilgrim Wick or any other person that may claim and the s^d two hundred and five acres of land to the s^d Samuel Wick his heirs and assigns forever (provides my s^d son Sam^l should survive me) against the claim of him the s^d Pilgrim Wick his Executors Administrators and against the claim of all and every Person to persons whatever shall and who will hereafter demand of him by these presents In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 5th day of May 1863 =
