Kind sir all in view by this presents that I William Bradshaw of the
County of St. Amptor being impelled to Negomie before the 1st of the
County afer^s in the just & full sum of Fifty one Pounds fifteen Shillings
Pound money of W^m & Co with lawfull Interest thereon from this
date and being in view and desirous to Secure the payment thereof
have as well for the consideration of the afores^s sum of Fifty one Pounds
fifteen Shillings as also for the sum of one Pound to me in hand
the Receipt whereof is hereby Accts^r. I the s^r W^m Bradshaw do
bargain & sale and by this presents do bargaine & sell unto the
W^m Bradshaw that tract or parcels of land lying in the
County afer^s which the s^r W^m Bradshaw bought from his brother
Philip Bradshaw for reference to that of & for bounds of the s^r land
to which tract of land I do my self myself bind & relinquish to the
W^m Bradshaw & Son all the rights title and claim to them and thru him
&c friends & to whom ever he may have given warrant and cause against
all persons and the same tract of land shall remain my right
Property until the signing of this Rec^r when it becomes the right
Property of the s^r W^m Bradshaw & Son to have and to hold unto
the s^r W^m Bradshaw & Son all the afores^s Property to the only pur
posse & intent of them the s^r W^m Bradshaw & Son his heirs and assigns
forever in Specie trust & Confidence to the s^r intent and Purpose that
that if the s^r sum of Fifty one pounds fifteen Shillings shall remain
unpaid to the s^r W^m Bradshaw & Son their heirs Executors Administrators
at or upon the 25th day of Decem^r next that then the afores^s s^r
Ruffin his heirs or assigns shall after giving reasonable Notice upon
the afores^s tract of land to Public Sale, at any time after the 25th
day of Decem^r next & with the money arising thereon first to pay
satisfy the afores^s sum of £ 51-15 - with lawfull Interest thereon &
costs as also the expenses attending the s^r trust over the surplus (if any)
to be returned to me the s^r W^m Bradshaw & Son heirs assigns &
to whom ever I have hereto set my hand this 26th day of
July in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and three
