This J^r WITNESS made this 19th day of July A.D. One thousand eight hundred and three between Edward Killeb of the Town of Ellumpris in the State of North Carolina on the one part and Thomas Ridley Smith of the County of Southampton State of Virginia on the other part Witnesseth that the sd Edward Killeb for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred pounds current money of Virg^a in hand paid to him the sd Ridley the Receipt whereof he sd the said Killeb hereby acknowledges granted bargained and sold aliened & confirmed unto the sd Thomas Ridley his heirs and assigns forever one certain Tract or Parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton afores^d and bounded as follows. *(Viz)* Beginning at a Hickory on the north side of James River three miles along sd Road three hundred and fifty eight poles to a large Oak a Corner in Benjamin Susis line thence along his line 128 p. to a small pine continuing along sd Susis line thence N. 51 W. 136 p. to a pine in Browns meadows thence down the various corners of the meadows 74 p. thence S. 60th down to a large East Eighty p. to a maple in a small Branch a pond of Browns meadows thence S. 100 p. to a pine at the head of sd Branch thence a few ight line to the beginning containing 318 Aers more or less & thence line to hold the sd 318 Aers of land with all the improvements &c. thence to belong to him the Thomas Ridley his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of the sd the Ridley his heirs and assigns forever, & the sd Edward Killeb sd the said him self Bryan and equal with the sd the Ridley his heirs and assigns ~~forever~~ that the sd Edward Killeb his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant defend the above mentioned land and premises unto the sd the Ridley his heirs and assigns forever, against all lawfull Claims of Persons of any Condition or Persons whatsoever, In Witness whereof I the said Killeb have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the day of the date above written -
