

This Indenture made this 24th day of December in the year of our Lord Christ
 1803, Between Samuel Williamson of the County of Hampshire of the one part
 and Nathl. Mabry of the County of Southampton of the other Part = Witnesseth
 that the sd. Samuel Williamson for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty
 Eight Dollars & Eighty Cents the Receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged
 hath bargained and sold and doth by these Presents bargain sell &
 convey unto the sd. Nathl. Mabry his heirs, Executors, Administrators assigns
 & assigns a small parcel tract or Piece of land containing four Acres
 and nine tenths of an Acre, to the same more or less, lying and being
 in the County of Southampton, on the North Side of the River, and
 between the following, Beginning on the 13 miles of the sd. River in the line
 of the sd. Mabry's Land, where he now liveth, thence along the sd. Mabry's
 land Round to the said River again, thence down the River to the
 Beginning to being the land of Peter known by the name of Broad
 Islands, It is here agreed to hold the sd. land and also its imper-
 tinences & advantages unto the proper use and behoof of him the sd.
 Nathl. Mabry his heirs, Executors Administrators & assigns forever and the
 sd. Samuel Williamson for him self, his heirs, Executors, and Administrators
 hath further Covenant, to and with the sd. Nathl. Mabry his heirs and
 assigns, that he will forever warrant and Defend the Right title
 and Interest of the sd. land unto him the sd. Nathl. Mabry his heirs and
 assigns forever - In Witness whereof the sd. Samuel Williamson hath
 to these Presents set his hand and affixed his seal the day & date above
 written.
