THIS INDENTURE made this 28th day of October 1805 and being the
 year of the independence of Virginia, between John George, and Susanna his
 wife, of the County of S^t Ampton of the one part, and Mark Suckins of the other part
 Witnesseth that the s^d John George and Susanna his wife
 for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred Dollars, to him in hand
 paid by the s^d Mark Suckins at & before the Seal of said County of these
 presents the receipt whereof the s^d John George and Susanna his wife fully
 acknowledge he the s^d John George and Susanna his wife have
 granted bargained and sold, aliened and confirmed and by these presents do
 grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the s^d Mark Suckins, his heirs
 executors and assigns of land lying and being in S^t Ampton County and Parish
 of the County of S^t Ampton being by Estimation 195 Acres more or less and bounded
 by the lands of James North, Barbara Lewis, and Andrew Smith, and the
 light water Swamp, reference thereunto being had will for the full & perfect
 and the division and parts and remainders and Remainders, parts and
 of the s^d premises and every part thereof, and also all the estate right
 title interest claim and advantage of him the s^d John George and Susanna
 his wife, & in and to the same premises and every part thereof, I have
 and to hold all and singular the s^d Premises above mentioned, and exceptant
 and parcel thereof, with the Appurtenances unto the s^d Mark Suckins
 his heirs and assigns forever, and the s^d John George and Susanna his wife
 for them selves their heirs &c. The s^d land and Premises conveyed unto the s^d
 against them and their heirs, and against all and every person whom
 he hath or shall and will in anywise and forever defend unto the s^d Mark
 Suckins his heirs and assigns forever. In Witness whereof the s^d John
 George and Susanna his wife hath hereunto set their hand and affixed the
 Seal of said County of these presents. Signed sealed &c. in presence of
