and Seizure of the lands and ornaments with no mentioned was given
and granted by the within named John George and Susanna his wife

At about half past the hour of 12 o'clock on the 10th day of January
1814 This Inventory was acknowledged by Mr. George and Susanna
his wife the being first fully examined at the law Courts and ordered
to be received —

This Inventory made this 10th day of January in the year of our Lord Christ
one thousand four hundred and three. Between Burrell Rawlings and Mary his wife of the
County, on one part; and Robert Rawlings of the aforesaid County of the other Part
Witnesseth that the said Burrell Rawlings for and in consideration of the sum
of fifteen pounds; to them in hand paid by the said Robt Rawlings the receipt whereof
of the said Burrell Rawlings and Mary his wife doth hereby acknowledge
in the said Burrell Rawlings both grantee long since and before Almond
Burrill and burrill Esq and by these presents doth grant to him & his wife
and assigns unto the said Robt Rawlings his heirs and assigns friend
no certain tract of land containing two or acres (to the same more or less) situated
lying and being in the County aforesaid and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at
a stone in the said line thence along the said fence line to a black pine tree
the said tree being in the said fence line of the said tract of land
thence in a straight line to Burrell Rawlings line, thence along of mark'd trees to
a stone in the said line in Burrell Rawlings line, thence a line compass
from the beginning with all trees, rocks, and stones, becoming common
of Pastures, fields, meadows, orchard, buildings, and plantations,
what and to the said tract of land above mentioned belonging in any way by
him, or is or upon the same growing, happening or arising and also the
fences and boundaries, boundaries and dimensions and areas of the
said premises and every part and parcel thereof, and also all the estate rights
etc, interest, property, claim and demands whatsoever of them the said Burrell
Rawlings and wife Mary of or unto the said premises and every part ther
of or have and to his lots are singularly the said premises above mentioned
and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto them the said Robt Rawl
lings his heirs and assigns, to the only person and behalf of him the said
Robt Rawlings his heirs and assigns especially over the said Burrell Rawlings premises
many for themselves & their heirs the said tract of land and every part thereof against
themselves and their heirs and against all and every other person or persons who
come to the said Robt Rawlings his land and assigns thereof and in witness
whereof signed before this 10th day of January in the year of our Lord
1814 and with many hands hereunto set their hands and seals the day and
year above written.
