 set of S.ampton County of the one part and Lewis Worrell of the afo<sup>d</sup> County  
 of the other part - Witnesseth that the s<sup>d</sup> Drew Bryant & wife for and in con  
 sideration of the sum of ten pounds to them in hand p<sup>d</sup> by the s<sup>d</sup> Lewis Worrell  
 the receipt whereof the s<sup>d</sup> Drew Bryant and wife hath granted bargained  
 and sold Aligned Enfeoffed and by these presents doth grant bargain and  
 sell alien Enfeoff and confirm unto the s<sup>d</sup> Lewis Worrell his heirs and assigns  
 forever one certain tract or parcel of land containing by Estimation forty  
 Acres (be the same more or less) Situate lying and being the County of S.amp  
 son and bounded as follows (Viz<sup>t</sup>) Beginning at a red oak a corner in s<sup>d</sup> Worrells  
 lines then N. 71<sup>st</sup> W. 116 p. a pine then S. 65<sup>th</sup> W. 26 p. a pine then S. 75<sup>th</sup> W. 55  
 p. a corner then S. 11<sup>th</sup> W. 61 p. a corner black gum in the Wolf pit bound  
 then S. 11<sup>th</sup> W. 61 p. a corner marked trees N. 76<sup>th</sup> W. 6. to the by lying red oak or
