of Sampson whereas Randolph, Nassum and Sally have by their Petition
alleged of bargain and sale dated the 18th day of January 1802 Envy
unto David Nassum of the County of Sampson the fee simple
estate of and in 1056 Acres of Land now know ye that when at the
Sally cannot conveniently travel to the Court of our s^d County to deliver
up the same therefore we do give to you power to receive the Acknow-
ledgment which the said Sally shall be willing to make before
you of the conveyance afores^d contained in the said Indenture which
is hereto annexed and we do therefore Command you to go personally
to the s^d Sally and examine her privately and apart from her s^d hus-
band whether she hath executed the s^d Deed freely and Volun-
tarily without the Persuasion or threat of her s^d husband and whether
she is willing the same should be recorded in the County of our s^d
County of S^t. on and when you have examined her as afores^d and taken the
Acknowledgment of the same that you Distinctly and openly Certify
on her of under your hands and Seal returning to us also this writ with
the s^d Indenture Annexed - Samuel Heller Clerk of our s^d Court at the
Office the 20th day of February 1804 and in the 28th year of the Com-
monwealth -

S^t. on have examined Mrs. Sally Nassum with regard to a tract of Land
conveyed to David Nassum and s^d Sally to David Nassum the 18th day of January
1802 and she hath freely and Voluntarily relinquished all right title claim
and pretence thereof and is willing and assents that the Deed should be recorded

At a Court held for the County of S^t. on the 18th day of January 1804
Indenture was Ack^d by R. Nassum and Bond^d for wife, and at a Court
also for the s^d County the 20th day of February 1804 This Indenture
with a Commission and Certificate was returned and is now to be recorded
