This Indenture made this 25th day of February in the year hundred
eight hundred and sixty four between Sir Magistrate of the County of Southampton
Surviving partner of William Wigham and Son of the one part and Mr
Bradshaw of the same County of the other Part: Witnesseth that
the said Sir Magistrate in consideration of having received from the
William Bradshaw the sum of fifty one pounds and sixteen Shillings
with the Interest due thereon the payment of which was secured to
William Wigham and Son by the said Mr. Bradshaw mortgaging
to them a tract of land lying in the said County of Southampton bearing the
same name of land bought by him the said William Bradshaw from his
brother Philip Bradshaw the sum of which may be seen by reference
to the record of purchase hath bargained and released unto him the said
Bradshaw all the said Sir Magistrate's title and Interest of and to the said
mortgaged premises; to have and to hold free from the claim of him the
said Wigham as surviving partner as afore said and free also from any claim
which in law or equity of his heirs executors or administrators and of the
Deputies or administrators of the said Wigham and the said John Wigham
shall hereafter demand and defend the said release against any
claim of his heirs executors or administrators as afore said and against
the claim of his heirs executors or administrators as afore said - In Testimony whereof he has
