This Indenture made this 18th day of May in the year of our said
 1804 between Zebulon Lewis and Rebecca his wife of the County of Sampson
 of the one part and John Reese of the said County of the other part, Witness
 -eth, that the said Zebulon Lewis and Rebecca his wife for and in consideration
 of the sum of Seventy Pounds & twelve Shillings, and Six Pence to them in hand
 paid by the said John Reese, at or before the making and Delivered to them
 presents, The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained and
 sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said John Reese
 his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract parcel or piece of land lying
 and being in the County of Sampson, and on the North side of the three Creeks
 containing by Survey fifty six and a half acres, be the same more or less, and bounded
 as followeth, Beginning at a pine a corner tree in the said Reese's line thence
 N 52^o E 12 poles to a black oak in the said Reese's line thence N 42^o E 18^o p.
 to a chestnut oak, at the bank of the said three Creeks, then up the various
 courses of the said Creeks, One hundred and eighteen Poles to a Persimmon tree,
 thence North ten Degrees West 156^o p. to a maple, thence 40^o p. to the
 beginning, together with all and singular the Advantages Appurtenant
 or in any manner belonging thereto, It has covenanted to hold, sell and give
 and one half acres of land with the tenement hereinafter, provided as follows
 this unto belonging or in any manner Appurtenant unto him the said John Reese
 his heirs and assigns forever, to the only Proper use and behoof of him the said
 John Reese his heirs and assigns forever and the said Zebulon Lewis and Rebecca
 his wife for themselves and their heirs the said land with all and singular the premises
 and Appurtenances before mentioned unto the said John Reese his heirs and assigns
 forever, free from the claim or claims of them the said Zebulon Lewis and Rebecca
 his wife or either of them, their or either of their heirs and all every or persons
 whatsoever, shall will and be inarrant, and forever released by these presents. In
