

This Indenture made this 21st day of May in the year of our late
 1804 between Lewis Thorp of the County of Brunswick of the one part and
 Robt Murrell of the County of Suffolk of the other part, Witnesses these
 Whereas by an Indenture bearing date the fourth day of April 1799 made
 between the said Robt Murrell and the said Lewis Thorp, the said Robt
 Murrell for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty pounds
 to be paid to the said Lewis Thorp there in and mentioned
 unto the said Lewis Thorp from the Robt Murrell he the said Robt
 Murrell did grant bargain & sell unto the said Lewis Thorp his heirs
 Executors Admrs or assigns one certain Tract or parcels of Land, containing
 by Estimation one hundred and fifty Acres more or less, lying and being
 in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows, by the lands of John
 David Judge Esq. In Thorp Decd and the land sold by the said Lewis
 Thorp to the said Robt Murrell also four Negroes (to wit) Sues Peter
 Mingo, Keesley with their families in excess, To have and to hold the same
 unto the said Lewis Thorp his heirs and assigns forever In which the said
 Indenture there is a Condition contained that if the said Robt Murrell his
 heirs Exrs or assigns should pay or cause to be paid unto the said Lewis
 Thorp his heirs or assigns the aforesaid sum of one hundred and fifty pounds
 with Interest within three years next after the date of the said Indenture
 That then the said Indenture was to Cease and to be Void and the said Sum
 to be repaid to the said Robt Murrell and to his heirs by the said Lewis
 Thorp or his heirs or assigns as by the said Indenture well more fully appears
 This Indenture Witnesses that the said Lewis Thorp stand in acknowl-
 edgment of the said sum of one hundred and fifty pounds to him in hand paid
 by the said Robt Murrell at or before the executing and delivery of
 these presents the receipt whereof the said Lewis Thorp doth acknowledge to
 the said Lewis Thorp hath received and surrendered unto by this present
 Assign release and Surrender unto the said Robt Murrell his heirs and
 assigns all one singular the said tract of land his estate and Annuity
 mentioned in and by the said receipt Indenture bargain & sold unto him
 the said Lewis Thorp is also the said four Negroes with their families and
 also all the estate right title Interest Claim and Demand whatsoever of him
 the said Lewis Thorp is in and to the premises aforesaid part thereof. It him
 and to hold the said tract or parcels of land and Premises above mentioned unto
 the said Robt Murrell his heirs and assigns forever and the said Lewis Thorp
 for him self his heirs and assigns forever of him doth Covenant and grant
 and unto the said Robt Murrell his heirs and assigns by these presents that
 he the said Lewis Thorp hath made no conveyance whatsoever by the means of
 release and Surrender or any part thereof may be in and to be in and to
 release or otherwise. In Testimony whereof the said Lewis Thorp hath
