

Know all men by these Presents that Abner Brown of the County of Hampshire and State of Virginia have this day bargained sold and Delivered unto Charles Riley of the County of Smith and State of Tennessee, one negro fine by the name of Cherry with all and every of his Appurtenances unto the said Charles Riley his heirs and assigns forever for the sum of three hundred Dollars some in hand paid by the said Riley, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged - which said sum of Cherry and increase I do hereby warrant and defend from myself my heirs and assigns &c and from all claims of all or any other person and Person whomsoever the only use benefit and behoof of the said Riley his heirs or assigns forever In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 21st day of April Anno Domini 1804.

This Indenture made this first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and four between John Bailey Son of the County of Hampshire of one part and Charles Riley of the County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Bailey for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and no pence lawful money of Virginia to him in hand by the said Charles Riley before the witnessing and signing of these presents the receipt whereof the said Charles Bailey doth hereby acknowledge Hence thereof; and every part and parcel thereof, doth fully, freely and absolutely Acquit, exonerate & Discharge the said Charles Bailey his heirs assigns and assigns by these presents, and for some other good causes and considerations him therunto moving he doth and John Bailey hath granted, bargained, and sold, alien to, enfeoffed, and confirmed and by these presents for himself his heirs and successors, do grant bargain, and sell, alien Enfeoff and confirm unto Charles Riley his heirs and assigns forever - one certain tract parcel of land containing three hundred and eighty nine acres, more or less, both the Willows to the same John Bailey by his father (Mr. Bailey) the other part to be held of Barnaby Bailey being and lying on the North side of the Light and Stream and Grand or Narrows branch in the County aforesaid, and bounded as follows to wit: for the said lands with &c. To have and to hold the said land hereby conveyed and sold and conveyed the premises herein before mentioned and intended to be hereby granted with the reversions and reversion remain and Remainders, Rents and Services of the premises, also all the water rights and other Claims and Demands of him the said John Bailey his heirs and assigns forever hereunto the said lands and Premises, every Part thereof with the Appurtenances
