 Court for that purpose; so that their proceeding therein be Committed
 to writing Signed by all Three of them, and ready to deliver when there-
 to Called by the parties of these Presents at any time after Sixty
 days from the date of these presents - and for the Standing to be
 standing by the division so as aforesaid made and delivered they the said
 Ann Gardner, Jesse Gardner and Betsy Gardner for them selves their
 heirs Executors and Administrators, do hereby bind themselves either or the
 sum of five hundred Dollars, to wit, that he, she, or they making
 default herein shall for such Default pay the said sum of five hun-
 dred Dollars to him she or them who may sustain injury by such default
 And always notwithstanding that nothing herein contained shall be
 deemed to authorize the Gentlemen aforesaid to divide the said
 Land in any other way than it would or ought to be divided if the
 Ladies were more numerous than In Witness Whereof they the said
 Ann Gardner, Jesse Gardner, and Betsy Gardner have hereunto set
 their hands and Seals this twelfth day of March 1804 -
