

This Indenture made this 7th day of April, 1766, between James Carrasco of Sampson of the first part, and Lewis Morris of the said County of Essex of the second part, Benjamin Barrett of the said County and State of the third part and Nathan Williams also of the same County and State of the fourth part, Whereas the said James Carrasco is Justly Incarcerated on the said Benjamin Barrett by bond bearing even date with this present

and Lewis Morris for Security Three hundred and Sixteen Dollars and Eighteen Cents, and the same James Carrasco being Ordealing and Resolving to Surrender the said Lewis Morris on Security for the payment thereof together with legal Interest thereon Accruing and also the cost of Drawing Recording and carrying into effect this Present, Now This Indenture

Witnesseth that the said James Carrasco in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Nathan Williams the receipt whereof is hereby Acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Nathan Williams his him and Assign forever the following property to wit two negroes being one Dinger two hundred and thirty three of my best feather bed

Ex? Furniture also all my house hold and kitchen furniture with three pair of increase to have and to hold the said two negroes two hundred and thirty three of my best bed and furniture also all the remainder of my house hold and kitchen furniture with three or more as before

unto him the said Nathan Williams his him and Assign to the only just and lawful behoof of him the Nathan Williams his him and Assign forever

And the said James Carrasco for him self his him Ex? and Assign doth Covenant and agree to and with the said Nathan Williams that he shall from time to time forever hereafter warrant and defend the title of the said two negroes to and their increase as aforesaid unto him the said Nathan Williams his him and Assign forever upon an especial trust and nevertheless and to and for the use maintenance and Purpose following that is to say, that he the said Nathan Williams shall at any time hereafter whenever he shall be therein Required by either of the parties or the said Lewis Morris not unwilling to stand bound as aforesaid in the said of the aforesaid two negroes be together with their persons and
