 This Indenture was Acknowledged by Luriers Washington

This Indenture made the 5th day of March 1791. Between Robert Darden
 and Honor his wife of the County of Sampson Ventr^{al} of the one part and
 George of the same place of the other part Witnesses etc. that the said
 Darden and Honor his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of fifty
 pounds good and lawful money of Virginia already in hand paid
 by the said Edward Gardner the receipt of which is to be seen to the said
 Darden and Honor his wife, doth hereby Acknowledge themselves
 fully and entirely Satisfied have bargained sold set over and Delivered
 by these presents doth bargain sell set over and deliver unto the said
 Edward Gardner his heir and Assigns forever — A certain tract or parcel
 of land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, Beginning
 at a Sweet gum standing in the Pocosin Branch, thence along
 of marked trees to a pine a corner of the said Partee, thence along
 their line to a pine, thence along their line to a black gum standing
 in the run of the Pocosin branch, thence along the run of the said
 branch to the beginning. The tract or parcel of land containing forty
 five Acres more or less together with all and singular the land tenements
 Profits, Commodities and Hereditaments thereon or therein belonging in
 anywise Appurtenant and also all and singular the services and re-
 -vues, services and annuities, and all and singular the estate right
 title Interest Claim and demands of them the said Robt Darden
 Honor his wife, their heir and Assigns forever, I Charles and to his
 the said Bargained Premises to the said Edward Gardner his
 and Assigns forever, and to the only proper use benefit and behoof
 him the said Edward Gardner forever, and the said Robt Darden
 Honor his wife for them and their heir Assigns the power of granting
 also the Appurtenances above mentioned and every part thereof against
 them their heir, and grants accords Grants other present or hereafter
 made the said Robt Darden and Honor his wife their heir and
 Assigns shall and lawfully warrant and forever defend the same
 Premises —
