This Indenture made this 10th day of July in the year of our Lord
 1804 between Thomas Chambliss of Wiltshire Chambliss of the
 County of Southampton, of the one part, and Nathaniel Chambliss of the County
 of Sussex of the other part, Witnesseth that whereas the said Thomas Cham-
 -bliss, became purchaser at his last will and testament of the land formerly owned by the
 said Nathaniel Chambliss and is of his last will and testament
