have bargained and Sold and by these presents, do, and each of them doth
bargain and Sell unto the said Joseph Drevoy his heirs and Assigns
Certain piece or tract of land Situate lying and being in the County
Parish &c the aforesaid County of Southampton, containing by Survey
Thirty six and one half Acres, be the same more or less, And beginning at a
point on the North side of John Cricklow and Emma's Wharf Mill pond
standing Old the edge of said Drevoy's office and run S. 45 E. 10
