

This Indenture made this 1st day of August 1803 betwⁿ John Woods
 and Sally his wife of the one part, and Ben^l. W. Schuster of the other part Witness
 that the said John Woods and Sally his wife have for and in con-
 sideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid
 by said Ben^l. Schuster and by their parent doth grant bargain sell
 and deliver unto the said Ben^l. Schuster and his heirs and assigns forever all
 that tract or piece of land which they purchased of said Drake beginning
 at a gum on John Faircloth's line thence along said Benjamin W. Schuster's
 line to a corner Maple thence along said line to John Day's line thence
 along that line to the Great house Swamp thence down the run of said
 Swamp to a branch a line of said Faircloth's thence up the said track to
 the gum begun at; - containing 50 Acres less the 1000 more
 or less together with all water Censures Orchards &c. belonging in or
 lying near the same. To have and to hold unto the said Ben^l.
 Schuster his heirs and assigns forever against the claim and demand of
 them the said John Woods and Sally his wife their heirs or assigns and
 against the claim and demand of all any other person and persons whatso-
 ever in the things whereof the said John Woods and Sally his wife have
 hereto set their hands and seals this said 1st day of August 1803
